

## **What procedures are in place to ensure confidentiality of documents?**

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Employees assigned to NAMA, as is the case with all other NTMA staff, are subject to section 14 of the National Treasury Management Agency Act, 1990 which prohibits an employee from disclosing any information obtained while carrying out their duties as employees of the NTMA.

In addition, employees assigned to NAMA are also subject to a prohibition on release of confidential data under Sections 99 and 202 of the NAMA Act 2009.

NTMA employees, including those assigned to NAMA, are also subject to the Official Secrets Act and contravention of these various legislative prohibitions is a criminal offence. The prohibition on disclosing confidential information applies indefinitely and extends to former employees.
